

**HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF ALAMEDA
PROJECT-BASED VOUCHER PROGRAM
AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS**

Issued: March 26, 2009

In 2007, the Housing Authority of the City of Alameda (AHA) issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) to solicit applications from property owners for its Project-Based Voucher (PBV) Program in 2007. In October 2008, some modifications to the program, now incorporated in the Administrative Plan, were made. The Housing Authority stopped taking applications for New Construction projects on May 29, 2007.

The Housing Authority continues to accept applications for Existing Construction. All interested parties are encouraged to read the program guidelines in Chapter 16 of the Administrative Plan, which is available on the Housing Authority's website at:

This Amendment No. 2 makes the following change:

The Administrative Plan governing the Section 8 Program, including the PBV component of that program has been amended as follows:

1. The application scoring criteria has been revised and is reflected in the revised application form. You should note that there is now a minimum score that must be achieved in order for an application to be considered.
