

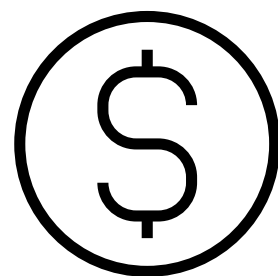
# Fact Sheet

## Housing Development



Currently AHA has 700+ affordable rental homes in the housing pipeline to be built by 2030, with 110 of those homes to be built by 2024.

The Alameda Affordable Housing Trust Fund, a trust fund established by AHA, has received \$10 million dollars in grants. This Trust Fund was created to dedicate funds to affordable housing construction in the City of Alameda.



The Housing Authority of the City of Alameda (AHA) is the owner of 845 affordable rental homes.

Since 2010, The Housing Authority of the City of Alameda has built 168 affordable rental homes for families, seniors, and other vulnerable community members.



Everett Commons (an AHA Community) won a 2021 Pacific Coast Builder's Golden Nugget Award for Best Affordable Housing Community – Under 30 dwellings per acre.
